Mission

The Colorado Pet Pantry temporarily feeds Colorado pets, allowing families to increase their ability to care for pets with the goal of keeping them out of shelters and with their families.

How Does Your Donation Help?

It costs \$4 for the Colorado Pet Pantry to feed a pet for a month. Combine that with the fact that your donation helps a pet stay with its family—keeping the dog or cat out of the shelter where it would need to be housed, fed, walked, cared for, and REHOMED—and your donation makes a huge difference!

Partnering

The Colorado Pet Pantry partners with local Food Banks and other organizations helping low-income families, distributing pet food from each partner location monthly so that entire neighborhoods have access to supplemental food for their pets when they need it the most. These partnerships reduce overhead costs and allow donations to directly support those in need, as well as help to ensure that human food is dedicated to the family's needs.
