How Does Your Donation Help?

It costs \$5 for the Colorado Pet Pantry to feed a pet for a month. Combine that with the fact that your donation helps a pet stay with its family—keeping the dog or cat out of the shelter where it would need to be housed, fed, walked, cared for, and REHOMED—and your donation makes a huge difference!

The Colorado Pet Pantry partners with local Food Banks and other organizations helping low-income families, distributing pet food from each partner location monthly so that entire neighborhoods have access to pet food when needed.
